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Categories that compete for the Prize money

Sparring

Juniors 14-17 years old, all the categories Blu – Black Belt;

Seniors 18 – 39 years old, all the categories Blu – Black Belt.

Rules for the Prize Money

all the categories indicated will participate in the prize money.

Regulation:

- The total amount of the Prize money is 10,000 euros which will be divided among the winning categories;
- Maximum prize per category 500€;
- the category to be admitted to the Prize money must have at least 15 participants; the prize money will be divided 60% to the first classified 20% to the second classified and the remaining 20% between the two athletes classified to the third place;
- If no category does not reach the number of 15 participants, the first two most numerous categories will be rewarded;
- The prize will be paid only by bank transfer to the Dojan belonging to the winning athlete as a contribution to participation in the international competition;
- It's mandatory for athletes who want to participate to stay in hotels selected by the organizing committee and book them through it.



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Umpires

- Head referee: Vice President of EITF Italy – Master Ruggiero Lanotte
- Each club should provide minimum one (1) ITF Qualified Umpire
- Umpires will be required to carry out their duties as scheduled.
- Umpires must attend all the Umpire Meetings scheduled in the period of the event.
- The Umpire's dress code will consist of the Navy blue blazer jacket, White long sleeved shirt, Navy blue trousers, Navy blue necktie, White short socks and White sport shoes as laid down in the Umpire rules.
- The Organizing Committee will cover 1 night (2 days) accommodation and provide lunch at the venue for all international umpires so **only if they are registered as umpires in the Accommodation Application Form!**

The Club which have not the referee have to pay 50 €.

Competitors

Competitor Dress Code:	Only the competitors who wear the Official ITF Dobok.
Club/Team requirements:	Club/Team must provide - 1 umpire/club or team for that have between 1 and 10 competitors, - 2 umpires/club or team for teams that have between 11 and 20 competitors, - 3 umpires/club or team for teams that have over 21 competitors.
Competitor numbers:	unlimited number/category at patterns and sparring, if there will be a category with just one competitor, he will move to the higher category.

Pyramid Elimination System will be applied to all competitors/divisions

The competitors will perform optional pattern (one by one) after another and then the designated pattern together!

Individual Sparring (Matsoki): Kids, Children, Juniors, Seniors - Male/Female The procedures will be analyzed in accordance with ITF&EITF tournaments rules.

Requirements: In the sparring competition, the competitor from the red corner must wear red safety equipments from hands and feet and the competitor from the blue corner must wear blue safety equipments from hands and feet.

Division:

- Kids 5 - 6 years / 7 – 8 years;
(Gup 10 – 9, 8-7; 6-5; 4-3; 2-1; I DAN; 2 round x 1 minutes)
- Kids 9 – 10 years
(Gup 10 – 9, 8-7; 6-5; 4-3; 2-1; I DAN; 2 round x 1 minutes and 30 seconds)

WHITE – GREEN

- Children 11 – 13 years
(Gup 10 -5 → 2 round x 1 minutes and 30 seconds)
- Juniors Gup 10 – 5 (14 – 15 years)
(2 rounds x 2 minutes, 1 minute Break)
- Senior Gup 10 – 5 (18 – 39 years)
(2 rounds x 2 minutes, 1 minute Break)
- Veteran Gup 10 – 5→ (1 round 1 minute and 30 seconds)



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BLU – BLACK

- Children 11 – 13 years
(Gup 4 – DAN → 2 round x 1 minutes and 30 seconds)
- Juniores Gup 4 – DAN (14 – 15/ 16 – 17 anni)
(2 rounds x 2 minutes, 1 minute Break)
- Senior Gup 4 – DAN (18 – 39 anni)
(2 rounds x 2 minutes, 1 minute Break)
- Veteran Gup 4 – DAN → (2 rounds 1 minute e 30 seconds, 1 minute Break)

YOUR INSIDER'S GUIDE – LOCAL LIFE, SIGHTSEEING TOURS AND ESSENTIAL VISITOR INFO

LOCATION & CLIMATE

Barletta is located in South Eastern Italy in Apulia. Its territory includes the roman archaeological site of Cannae and the Valley of Ofanto - the river which crosses the countryside. The city overlooks the sea and its sandy coast extends for 13 km, far beyond the Old Town original site and harbor. The climate is mild for most of the year, with a very hot summer (July/August) and chance of snow flurries in January/February. The average temperature ranges from 8.7°C in January to 24.7°C in August. All seasons are good in terms of congress activities.





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CONNECTIONS

By Plane



“Karol Wojtyła” International Airport of Bari:

The nearest airport to Barletta is the “Karol Wojtyła” International Airport of Bari (BRI), also known as Palese Airport. It is a main centre for departures to and from most European countries.

The Airport is located 55 km south of Barletta and there are ground transportation solutions for visitors landing in Bari.

→ From the “Karol Wojtyła” Airport to Barletta

By car → The ring road and the SS 16-bis trunk road (Statale Adriatica) connect the Airport to Barletta.

By train/bus → The Bari Metropolitan Railway Service (Ferrotramviaria or Nord Barese) connects the Airport with the “Bari Centrale” Railway Station in the city centre: the single fare is €5. Also, the AMTAB public transportation provides a good connection by bus from the Airport to the city centre of Bari (Line 16: Aeroporto Terminal Partenze - Stazione FS Piazza Moro).

From Bari Centrale, the regional railway connects Bari to Barletta: the single fare is €4.20 (train direction: Foggia).

By Train





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There are quick and regular links to many cities in the country that will lead you to our Central Railway Station, which is very close to the Old Town.

If you came inland by plane and landed in Naples, Rome, Pescara, Bologna or Milan, don't worry! Check out the National Railway Service website trenitalia.it and see which train suits you best for reaching Barletta. The cost of a single fare can vary very much and we suggest booking the tickets in advance.

By Car

Barletta is served by the Autostrada Adriatica A14 (A14 motorway), linking it to Bologna and Milan to the north and to Bari to the south. You can exit or enter the motorway by the "Andria-Barletta" motorway tollbooth. Also, check out the bus fares from your town of arrival in Italy

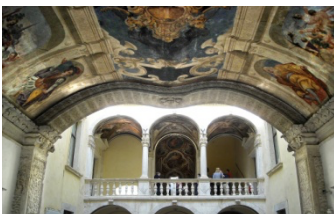
THE OLD TOWN

The Old Town is the heart of the cultural life and leisure.

Here a short visitor's guide for enjoying your time in Barletta by day and by night!

IF YOU LOVE ART AND ARCHITECTURE

You can take a good sightseeing tour of the Old Town with little effort. All the main cultural sites and museum are located in the same area and they are all within easy walking distance of each other.



Are you into art galleries and art exhibitions? We would love to suggest you to go visiting our Pinacoteca "Giuseppe De Nittis" at Palazzo della Marra, which displays Impressionist paintings by De Nittis – a famous 19th-century Italian painter. If you enjoy sightseeing, take a break from the congress activities and go savouring our local history and architecture! The two main churches in town are the Cathedral of Santa Maria Maggiore, the very heart of the Old Town, and the Basilica of



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the Holy Sepulchre, which frames the silhouette of the Colossus also known as Eraclio. St Andrew's Church, nearby the Cathedral, is worth a visit, too. Its catacombs are not open to the public but you may find it interesting anyway – a truly beautiful location with some lovely views.

The Castle, a Norman-Swabian fortress built by the will of King Frederick II (whose only existing visual representation is treasured in the Civic Museum of Barletta), is a good place to chill out when it's sunny and warm outside: bring over some snacks and drinks and enjoy your time in the park.



NIGHTLIFE: LEISURE, FOOD AND DINING

You can find plenty of restaurants, pizzerias, pubs and bars. For enjoying some Italian or local food you don't have to go downtown since there are good alternatives also in other areas of the town, also if you love sushi and Japanese cuisine.

Still, if you are looking for the Old Town is the beating heart of nightlife. There are no clubs in town but still you can manage to spend a good night out with friends in the many pubs and bars! Public transport is suspended at night but Barletta is not very big, you can do it for sure.





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ONE-DAY TOURS IN THE LOCAL AREA

TRANI

13 km from Barletta

There are cheap regional trains for Trani: the round trip is €2.20.

You may find interesting to go visiting its Cathedral and taking a walk along its beautiful waterfront.



CASTEL DEL MONTE

34 km from Barletta

A 13th-century citadel and castle situated on a hill in Andria. The castle was built by the will of King Frederick II. The castle and the woods greet the eyes and the site is part of the UNESCO World Heritage.





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BARI

55 km from Barletta

Bari is the main city in Apulia. There are regional trains for Bari: the round trip is €8.40.

You can visit its Fortress, the Cathedral of San Sabino, the Basil of St Nicholas, the Petruzzelli Theatre, and Bari vecchia (the Old Bari) – the ancient area of the city, undamaged by the fast pace of the city during rush hour. Bari is where focaccia barese and panzerotti were born, and yes, we do warmly suggest you to taste this glorious food at least once in your lifetime!



ALBEROBELLO

115 km from Barletta

Its trulli (conical-roofed houses) are iconic and you cannot miss them if you are visiting Southern Italy. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a delightful experience for both the locals and the travellers. Grab your sunglasses, have some ice cream and take a walk down its narrow streets and cafes.



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MONOPOLI

95 km from Barletta

The views you can see in Monopoli are so beautiful they look just like a postcard. If you come visiting our region in the May/September period, you can surely take a swim in Monopoli: its beaches have crystal clear water and some of the most incredible cliffs in Apulia.
