### IAPT MEMBERS

Enclosed with this newsletter you will find a list of people who are recorded with the ITF as being paid up members of the IAPT. Should you have paid your membership fee and your name does not appear on the list then please inform the ITF HQ immediately. You should give your personal details including date of grading and certificate number.

### GRADING EXAMINATION

In order to help those who wish to grade for 4th. degree or higher, when they do not have a Master Examiner who lives in that country, there will be a grading during the time of the VIIth. World Championships in Canada. The people who wish to take the grading must take part in the umpire course. They must write to the ITF HQ that they will take part in the course and this means that they must also be an umpire at the championships. **The grading form must be taken to the grading and not sent to the ITF HQ.** The grading form must be typewritten and filled in with all details, including a Plaque number for which the fee has been paid, signed by the President or his authorised representative and you must have the photographs with it. **You must send your personal history and thesis to the ITF HQ IMMEDIATELY and at the same time you must send a copy of the grading form to the HQ.** The grading will, most likely, be held on the 17th. of August.

If everything is not complied with then you will not be able to grade.

### UMPIRE COURSE

Anyone who has an umpire class 'B' certificate and wishes to sit for an umpire class 'A' certificate may do so by attending the umpire course at the VII World Championships. They should have an application form filled in and signed by the national association and take it with them to the course. If they judge at the World Championships then the accomodation will be paid for them at the course and the championships. If they do not judge at the championships then they must pay their own expenses.


