## TALKS BETWEEN THE PRESIDENTS OF IOC AND ITF

The ITF President Prof. Chang Ung held the talks with the IOC President at his office on May 30, 2008.



Prof. Chang Ung explained in details about the current situation of the talks between ITF

and WTF to Dr. Jacques Rogge, the IOC President, and shared the views how to make the progress on it.

They reached the common agreement that it should be settled down as soonest as possible in accordance with the requirements and interests of the Taekwon-Doists in the world and there is, too, a necessity to take the due measures for it.

The IOC President asked Prof. Chang Ung to submit the proposal to cope with it and it would be discussed at the Joint Meeting to be presented by the Presidents of ITF and WTF. This meeting is expected to be chaired by the IOC President during the Beijing Olympic Games.

## THE 8<sup>th</sup> JUNIOR & 3<sup>rd</sup> VETERAN TAEKWON-DO WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP WAITS FOR YOU



The organizing Committee for the above Championship confirmed that they are pouring a lot of energies and times into the preparation for the 8th Junior & 3rd Veteran Taekwon-Do World Championship under the great attention and cooperation with the Uzbekistan Government.

The Uzbekistan Government promised them to do their best for its success including the financial supports and guaranteed the security for the participants in the periods of this event.

As long as the participants respect and follow the schedules of the Championship, you will

stay in Tashkent safely and if you have something to do urgently and abruptly outside the schedules set forth by the Organizing Committee, you are requested to inform it to the Organizers in advance. However, the daily life circumstances and surroundings in Tashkent are much more peaceful and safe than you are expecting and everything is in order and disciplined.

For the visa process, the Organizing Committee is now under the talks with the respective Governmental Department to issue the visa to the participants, who are in difficulties to get it in their countries, at the Tashkent Airport upon arrival and, therefore, the participants from the countries where there are no the Uzbekistan Embassies are cordially advised to contact the Organizing Committee and forward the particulars for your visa to them with no delay.

At 2 pm on Sep. 19th 2008, ITF is going to convene its 18th Congress in the Hotel "Uzbekistan" and the NGBs are allowed to send up to 3 delegates to the Congress and the NGBs who can not come to the Congress with a certain reason are able to trust any NGB with the "PROXY" and must inform it to the ITF HQ in advance. The agendas would be notified to you soon in due course.

As normally, ITF is scheduling to hold the 3-Day-Technical & Umpire Course from 14th to 16th Sep. 2008 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan just before the Championship. It will be conducted by the Chairpersons of the ITF Technical Committee and Umpire Committee and only the Umpires who attend this course are eligible to be umpiring at the coming Championship. The course fee is USD 50,00 per person and will be open to everybody willing to come to this course and hotel accommodations should be paid by the participants during the seminar.
