A reminder that you must be an international instructor and hold an international instructor certificate before you can grade people to a higher level, this includes kup gradings. Should you not have a certificate then you should apply now, of course you must be qualified for the certificate by having taken an international course and being 4° or above.

JUNIOR BLACK BELTS

The procedure for promotion for younger students seems to be misunderstood and the following procedure for black belts is to be followed. Up to 12 years of age a person may be promoted to 1st. Degree only. If a person is promoted to 1st. degree when they are only 9 years old then they must wait until they are 13 years old before they may be promoted to 2nd. degree.

SOVIET UNION

Since the international community is granting separate recognition to many of the, former, Soviet countries, the ITF is granting recognition to many of these new countries. We welcome them to the ITF and you should all be aware that these new TKD Associations wish to communicate with other members. The ITF have given addresses to these new countries and they may write to you. We will give more details as the situation is clarified.
