SAFETY EQUIPMENT

The official ITF approved equipment with logo must be worn and you will not be permitted to compete otherwise.

OFFICIAL TULS

For the Championships Kwang-Gae, Po-Eun, and Gae-Baek will be used. You are advised that any of the patterns from Chon-Ji to Chung-Moo may be used as the designated pattern.

OFFICIAL DOBOK

The official ITF uniform must be worn at the Championships. The only variation permitted is to wear your national flag, which must not be over-large (12cm x 12cm). TAKE NOTE OF ALL THIS. You must also have your ITF life membership card and small certificate with you.

UMPIRES

Those who intend to participate should note that they should have written to Master Han Sam Soo, Chairman of the Umpire Committee, at 1606 New York Avenue, Arlington, Texas 76010, giving details of their 'A' class certificate number and enclosing 2 photographs, also details of degree held and date of birth. You must also conform to the rules and regulations for umpires which are enclosed.

HOTEL BILLS - FOOD

The ITF will pay for the following:

Hotel overnight from 21st. May to 25th. May inclusive (5 nights).
Continental breakfast in Hotel from 22nd. to 26th. May (5 mornings).
Mid-day and evening meals in the stadium from 22nd. to 24th. May.

NATIONAL FLAG/ANTHEM

You are required to bring your National Flag with you. The size should be about 3 feet by 2 feet or 1 metre by 0.6 metre. You should also bring a cassette tape with your National Anthem (song) on it.

The educational videos with patterns up to Tong-Il are now available and you should write to the ITF HQ to place your order. These tapes are the ideal companion for the encyclopaedia and your performance and knowledge will be enhanced. Due to unfortunate experiences in the past where people have 'ripped off' the expensive outlay by copying items themselves the films are only being sold in quantity. They are also only being sold to Governing Bodies or Regional Directors. The minimum quantity being sold is 20 tapes and the cost per tape is \$ 150.00 (US). 50 tapes cost \$ 140.00 (US) per tape and 100 cost \$ 130.00 (US) each. 200 cost \$ 120.00 (US) each and all costs do not include postage.

INTERNATIONAL INSTRUCTOR AND UMPIRE COURSES

All members of European countries must come to Vienna for these courses and others will be arranged as approved by the ITF.

DETAILS REQUIRED

All National Governing Bodies must supply the following information to the ITF HQ to facilitate the programming of the computer and address list:

Instructor name, address of home and school, date of birth, telephone number (home and business), degree, ITF certificate number. Also the details of all black belts as above.

You are reminded that all certificate applications must have the ITF certificate number filled in for those already in possession of same. Should you not fill in the number then you must give a reason for not complying. Should you not fill in the number then the application will be returned.
