At the present time we say that a junior for promotion is anyone under 13 years of age. If we wish to promote someone to 2nd. Dan they must be an adult. That means from 13 years old, but can we count the time waiting as a junior towards promotion as a senior? or does the time start from the age of 13 and they can only be promoted at 14½ years old? In competition we say that a junior is anyone under the age of 18. We must have a system which makes it clearer. In some cases the term "Peewee" is used for very young children. Please write to the ITF with your suggestions about this. Do NOT sit back and wait for someone else to write, please write yourself.
